

2025 High School Playwriting Project PROJECT GUIDELINES + REQUIREMENTS

Submissions that do not adhere to all guidelines and requirements will be disqualified

FORMATTING

- 1. Type in Times New Roman, 12-point font; 7 12 pages MAX
- 2. Plays must follow this basic playwriting format:
 - a. One inch margins (left, right, top, bottom)
 - b. Character names in all caps centered above the dialogue
 - c. Single-spaced dialogue with double spacing between units of dialogue
 - d. Stage directions in parentheses, single-spaced, indented from dialogue
 - e. Pages numbered on bottom right
 - f. Title of the play must appear at the top of each page
- 3. Include no more than 6 characters unless double cast
- 4. Write a complete play, not a scene
- 5. Before submitting, please proof read for possible spelling or grammatical errors.
 - Allowable exceptions include dialect and character choices within the dialogue.

SUBMISSION MATERIAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Submissions should include two (2) separate PDF files.
 - a. PDF #1 is your TITLE PAGE and should include the following:
 - Playwright's name, home address, telephone number & email
 - Teacher's name, high school address, telephone number & email
 - File name when saving the document should be:
 - [Play Title]_Title Page | For example: "Our Town_Title Page
 - Visual Example available on Circle's HSPP Website
 - b. PDF #2 is your SCRIPT that does NOT contain the title page or any other identifying information beyond the title of play
- 2. Teachers should submit both files in PDF format through the links on circletheatre.com/hspp
- 3. A signed and dated Teacher's Letter of Support, with a list of student participants, should accompany your submissions or be emailed in advance.
- 4. Deadline for the receipt of all uploaded submissions is March 1, 2025.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1. No more than one play should be submitted by any one student
- 2. The play should be written for the purposes of the 2025 HSPP only, pre-written scripts should not be submitted.
- 3. Scripts MAY be submitted to other contests following HSPP 2025, but not prior to
- 4. Students may co-write plays with up to three authors
- 5. If any student does not have regular access to a computer for electronic submission, please contact the theater for further instruction
- 6. Plays may be submitted in English or Spanish, please contact the theater if a writer is interested in writing in a different language.
- 7. AI may not be used in the writing of the scripts
- 8. Circle Theatre will collect up to the top 20 scripts for a printed copy to be available for sale at the Finalist Reading Series. Authors will be credited.
- 9. Selected entries will be announced in April of 2025.
- 10. All playwrights and teachers are invited to the Finalist Reading Series which will take place at Circle Theatre on May 4, 2025.
- 11. Finalist playwrights are invited to have their script read by professional actors as a part of the Finalist Reading Series. Should the playwright not be able to attend the Finalist Reading Series, they will still receive a scholarship, however, an alternate play will be selected for the presentation.
